• Visa Requirement

It is the hunter's responsibility to obtain their **Turkish Visa** as soon as possible.

Please carry **2 colored copies** of your visa in your passport during travel.

• International Flights

All international flights must be booked as **one single ticket** through **Turkish Airlines** when traveling to Türkiye.

• Rifle & Ammunition Check-Through

Rifles and ammunition must be checked through to the **final destination**, Turkish Ground Services and airport regulations do not permit rifle storage at the airport for more than 24 hours. If you have a stop or sightseeing tour in Istanbul, we can also arrange our rifle clearance service in Istanbul and coordinate the process for you.

• Rifle & Ammunition Airline Packing Standards

All rifles and ammunition must be packed in compliance with airline and TSA/IATA regulations.

– **Rifle & Ammunition must be stored in hard, secure separate cases.**

– **Ammunition must NOT be placed inside your checked luggage.**

– Ammunition must be packed separately, as **Turkish Ground Services (TGS)** receives rifles and ammunition upon arrival and transfers them to a **separate secure area** than that of your personal luggage.

• Traveling With Two Rifles Under Different Names

If two hunters are traveling with rifles registered under separate names, each rifle must be transported in its **own individual rifle case**.

No rifle case may contain a firearm belonging to another hunter.

• 4457 Form Requirement

Each hunter's **4457 Form** must match the **exact rifle** (serial number, make, caliber).

Forms cannot be used on behalf of another hunter.

• Hunting Permit & Invitation Letter

Your official **Hunting Permit** and **Invitation Letter** will be sent to you closer to your hunting date.

These documents must be shown to airline **check-in staff** before departure to Türkiye.

• Flight Routing & Baggage Reliability

The safest and most reliable way to travel with rifles and ammunition when flying to Türkiye is to book your entire itinerary as **one continuous ticket with Turkish Airlines**.

Rifle and luggage mishandling most commonly occurs when **multiple airlines or extra connections** are involved. While Wild Hunting Outfitters cannot accept responsibility for lost baggage or delayed rifle transfers under any airline, **flying Turkish Airlines significantly reduces these risks** and allows us to assist you **much more effectively** with local ground teams and airport authorities should any irregularity occur.

Weather Expectations










- **October – November 15:** 45–75°F (7–23°C)
- **November 15 – December 20:** 32–60°F (0–15°C) with rain and snow
- **February – March 15:** 30–58°F (-1–14°C) rain and possible snow
- **March 15 – April:** 35–65°F (2–18°C) cool with light rain, early spring conditions

RIFLE & SHOOTING EQUIPMENT

- 6.5 caliber rifle with minimum 140 gr hunting bullets
- Practice at least 100 rounds at 300 yards (consistent 3-shot groups under 2")
- Ballistic chart / wind drift data taped on rifle stock
- High-quality riflescope with reliable turret system
- Bipod or lightweight shooting sticks
- Rangefinder with true ballistic range calculation
- Spotting scope and tripod (optional, recommended)
- Compact rifle cleaning kit
- Duct tape / black tape for barrel protection
- Mid-sized tripod for seated shots (RRS or Spartan)
- Compact shooting bag
- All essential tools for your rifle and scope

OPTICS & ESSENTIAL GEAR

- High-quality binoculars (10x40 or 10x42 minimum)
- Leki or similar trekking poles
- Headlamp with extra batteries
- Digital camera with charger and spare batteries
- Rainproof day backpack
- Trophy tags with personal address and customs broker address



CLOTHING (LAYERING SYSTEM)

Base Layers

- Merino wool or synthetic lightweight tops and bottoms

Mid Layers

- Synthetic fleece jacket and pants
- Insulated vest or lightweight puffer jacket

Outer Layers

- Lightweight waterproof/windproof rain jacket and pants
- Soft-shell hunting pants
- Gaiters (December–March; snow conditions)

Footwear

- High-quality ankle-high mountain boots with good flexibility
- Breathable wool socks (several pairs)
- Spare boot laces
- House shoes / lodge slippers

- Lightweight gloves + insulated cold-weather gloves
- Fleece neck warmer
